The TACCSTM product does not provide a separate "Authoring Tool" interface. Consequently, all answers, conformance and remarks related to "Authoring Tool" have been removed as "Not Applicable". Documentation is provided in PDF file format as a standard document with some non-essential images except as noted below in relation to map interface guidance. The accessibility of this documentation is governed by the accessibility of the tools used to view it. Therefore, the conformance level and remarks as they relate to "Electronic Docs" have been removed from the table and should be considered as "Supports."

One of the core capabilities of the TACCSTM product is the delivery of a visual common operating picture (COP) within the geospatial environment and through a map-based presentation medium that serves as the principal interface for users. For that reason, a common accessibility explanation below is that there are some parts of the software that rely upon the visualization of data. That use of visualization does not preclude the use of other non-visual aspects of the software by users with limited vision.
